This is a one year free membership.	Aspire Lessons are a 15 minute small group lesson on club ice with 30 minutes to practice on your own.

	Our regular quarterly registrations take place in May (June-Aug. ice), August (Sept.-Nov. ice), November (Dec.-Feb. ice) & February (March-May ice).
	Emails are sent out when registration opens each quarter.
You can upgrade your membership at any time during the year!	If you are registering for the 1st time outside of our regular quarterly registration we will pro-rate the fee and a late fee will not apply.
